The First Danube Region Road Safety Conference: “Towards an Increased Road Safety in the Danube Region, towards Zero Vision”

LJUBLJANA, Slovenia, 20th – 21st of May 2015

Government authorities, policy makers, lead experts and international academia will gather in Ljubljana for a two-day conference to discuss road safety in the Danube region. **Present and future road safety relevant challenges, solutions and best practices** for the Danube macro-region and beyond will be presented and discussed. The conference will focus on road safety in 14 countries of the Danube region, road safety soft and hard measures, improvement and development of road infrastructure, road safety management and human behaviour in traffic.

The conference is organized by: EUSDR PA1b coordinators, the Slovenian Ministry of Infrastructure, the Slovenian Traffic Safety Agency, Automobile Association of Slovenia, Faculty of Civil and Geodetic Engineering (University of Ljubljana) and Faculty of Civil Engineering (University of Maribor).
